Our Spiritual Posture – February Letter 2025

Dear Friend,

Paul wrote these words in Ephesians chapter 3: “For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named.”

Bowing his knees was considered by Paul to be an expression of his humility, surrender, and yielding to the perfect plan that God had for his life and the church at Ephesus.

Paul was not just speaking of his physical posture, but rather the spiritual posture or disposition of his heart. He was describing a place of absolute surrender in humility as he positioned himself to offer up a prayer for the Christians at Ephesus. Let’s look at that prayer.

THE PRAYER

Ephesians 3:14 For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,

Ephesians 3:15 Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named,

Ephesians 3:16 That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man;

Ephesians 3:17 That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love,

Ephesians 3:18 May be able to comprehend with all saints what *is* the breadth, and length, and depth, and height;

Ephesians 3:19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

Ephesians 3:20 Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,

Ephesians 3:21 Unto him *be* glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen.

The cause for which Paul surrendered his body in kneeling was a plea that God would grant to the Christians at Ephesus the ability to be strengthened with might (Greek word: “dunamis” ...dynamite, explosive power) by the Holy Ghost in their individual spirits.

If God could do this for them, then Paul knew that God would be able to reveal Himself in the unfathomable dimensions of His love: the breadth, the length, the depth, and the height. Then, nothing would be impossible.

Paul knew this, that if the members of the church at Ephesus could somehow come to know the revelation knowledge of the love of God by true experience, the kind that goes beyond all human knowledge, then they would be filled with the fullness of God. That fullness would then interpret

out and begin to show them that every impossibility had become possible. “Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us” (Ephesians 3:20).

THAT SOUNDS LIKE REVIVAL.

THAT SOUNDS LIKE THE BOOK OF ACTS ON STEROIDS!

THAT SOUNDS LIKE JOEL’S ARMY CONSUMING THE EARTH WITH SIGNS AND WONDERS!

GLORY!!!!

This all started with the posture of Paul’s heart in humility. There is a wave of God’s glory and presence that is scheduled to sweep this nation and planet into a Revival that this world has never seen before. It will start and come to fullness as the PRAYING CHURCH continually humbles itself in a position of “bowing the knees of their hearts!”

Recently, the Lord said to me, “Pride is the opposite of humility! To know and not do is the epitome of pride!”

In other words, to know and understand the instructions that God has given us and yet refuse to do them, whether deliberately or passively, is pride.

There is a group of people in the Body of Christ that suffer needlessly in different areas because they will not humble themselves and do the instructions they have heard, which God has given to His entire Body.

God has repeatedly asked His Body to come away with Him in times of intimacy and prayer. Whether it has been from what we refer to as the “Blueprint Prophecies” or a multitude of other wonderful present-day speaking prophecies coming from many other locations, the message is all the same: “Humble yourselves and come away with Me!”

To repeat the instruction that God gave to one of our spiritual leaders a few years ago for the purpose of the coming outpouring Revival...

“Humble yourself and humble yourself. And when you think you have humbled yourself as much as possible, then humble yourself again!”

The physical posture of the body in prayer is not so important. It is the BOWING THE KNEES OF THE HEART in humility and saying yes to the instruction of the Lord to come away with Him for change and the birthing of this present-day Revival that God is looking for.
