Rejoice. Rejoice. Again I say, rejoice. Brighten up. Brighten yourself up. Brighten up. In times when I have said rejoice, when Paul said rejoice, where was he when he said rejoice? When Paul and Silas were rejoicing, where were they? Are you not in times like this, in places where you feel that you are in prison? But I say, rejoice. Brighten up. Cheer up. Cheer up, this morning. Cheer up.

Rise up; stand up; cause your shoulders to stand back up, and be men and women of God this morning. I tell you this morning that the Gospel is good news. When you are receiving bad news, I tell you that I am the God of good news. When they say to you that you are given bad news, when they come with bad news in letters, when they say to you this is what is happening, when they say you are losing this, say, "I have a God who is good news, good news. I will stand on good news this morning."

Lift your shoulders. Stand on good news, because you do not lose when you are crushed, and you are standing up against perilous times and the times that back you up against a wall, and you say, "How am I going to get out of this?" I tell you this, that you will not lose because I am a God who will let you stand in the days that you are living in that are perilous times—you will not lose.

Brighten up this morning. Cheer up, stand up and say, "I have the Word, and the Word will not let me fail. The Word will not let me move, and I have a God who will not let me fail."
