You Must Choose to Worship Me

It's the lack of understanding in My Body concerning praise and worship that keeps people from being obedient unto Me, says the Lord. My command for you to worship Me and the Father's desire for those to worship Him in spirit and in truth comes from the same place of your determination to live holy out of a spirit that is created in righteousness and true holiness, says the Spirit of Grace.

I did not ask you to feel like praising Me. I did not ask you to do it if all of your thoughts were concentrated solely at one moment before you began. Why do you suppose that the Word describes it as the sacrifice of praise? For many look at others who engage in worship and say, "They are spiritual and they're able to set themself apart at the moment." But understand this, that the greatest worshippers are those who are often times engaged in a battle of their mind and their emotions. But they choose for that moment in time to set all things aside and put all things under their feet, to devote themselves solely unto praise and unto worship. And until you begin to walk in such obedience, you will never begin to cross the line to where that your worship and your praise comes to a place of maturity and advances.

Some have asked the question, "Can I worship the Lord quietly and it still have the same effect?" At times, yes. But there must come forth out of you at times, when I'm asking you, a volume of your voice by which you yourself can hear your own praises going up before Me. Know this, that I said in My Word it is out of the mouth of babes and sucklings, out of the mouth of worshippers that I will still the voice of the enemy. The enemy is being allowed to speak louder than your worship. Your worship ought to speak louder than the enemy, says the Spirit of Grace. Do not wait for a season in which you feel the presence and the exuberance to worship. Choose this day and every day to worship Me and to praise Me, says the Spirit of Grace.
